

Lacey's Story

2009	Broodmare out on summer pasture	Condition	No lameness - Tendon visible
Costs	Schreiner's \$48.00 , Wraps \$22.00	Supplies	2 bottles Schreiner's, Gamgee cloth, leg quilt & Vet wrap.



DAY 1: Mare had been out on large pasture and came in with this wound. When found, suspect it to be about 2 days old.

This photo was just after hosing off the dead strips of skin. The edges are hard and curling up. The vet was not called. The mare had already had her Tetanus vaccination.



END OF WEEK 1: Leg was treated every 2 days, being hosed with cold water, sprayed with Schreiner's, and wrapped. I also sprayed the wound cloth with Schreiner's. This allowed the edges to soften and lay back down.



END OF WEEK 3: After continuing with the same routine as above for 2 weeks, I discontinued the wrapping of the leg. This allowed me to treat with Schreiner's no less than 3 times a day. I hosed the leg if it became dirty.



END OF WEEK 5: Beautifully healed, small scab, using nothing but Schreiner's Herbal Solution. No vet. No stitches. No antibiotics.
